





## On a group level:



The Grade 12s of 2024 have achieved the highest number of Bachelor Degree passes than any previous year. Of the 61 who completed the exams, 56 of them met the criteria to apply for a bachelor's degree at a university.

Across the Grade, students achieved 113 distinctions. In 61% of all examinations written, our students achieved 70% or higher. This is testimony to high levels of academic aspiration and many hours of dedicated work.







# On a subject level:



Special mentions: Each of the following subjects achieved a distinction rate of 40% or more.

### History:

54% of the students achieved distinctions and 29% achieved B's

### **Dramatic Arts:**

78% of the students achieved distinctions. The rest of the class achieved B's.

# Geography:

40% of the students achieved distinctions with a further 30% achieving B's.


# Mathematical Literacy:

48% of the students achieved distinctions. A further 30% achieved B's.

### Visual Arts:

46% of the students achieved distinctions with a further 27% achieving B's.

# Steps to follow if you are unhappy with your results:

The following information provides clarity relating to the remarking, rechecking of the answer scripts and applications for the 2025 May NSC Examination.

## **Remarking and Rechecking**

Applications and payment for remarks and rechecks must be completed online at <a href="www.ieb-online.co.za">www.ieb-online.co.za</a>. The final date for applications is **Friday**, **31 January 2025**. **No late applications will be accepted**.

The fee per subject for a remark is R970 (incl. VAT). The answer scripts for that subject will be sent to the Chief Examiner to be remarked. Oral, School Based Assessment and Practical Work will not be reassessed.

The fee per subject for a recheck is R491 (incl. VAT). The question papers will be checked to ensure all questions have been marked and totaled, and that all marks have been correctly entered. Appropriate action will be taken if errors are found but no remarking will take place.

Remark/recheck results will be released on 28 February 2025, subject to approval by Umalusi.

### **2024 NSC Examination Certificates**

All the 2024 NSC examination certificates will be sent directly to Cedar House by the end of May 2025. We will inform you via email once the certificates have been delivered for collection.

### **2025 May NSC Examination**

Applications for the May examination must be completed online at <a href="www.ieb-online.co.za">www.ieb-online.co.za</a> and payment must be done via the online application. The portal for applications is only opened once the remark results are released.
